Paper Submission

In order to promote the activities of ADM community and allow dissemination of research products, participation in the workshop is combined with a special issue of the "*International Journal on Interactive Design and Manufacturing*". A selection of papers will be published in the special issue before the beginning of the workshop.

Full papers have to be submitted before May 1, 2012. Paper submission guidelines and instructions will be provided as they become available.

The registration for co-authors and auditors has to be completed by **July 30, 2012**. The registration fee is 250€
